### Note from the Executive Director

The past year was a time of transition and reinvention for Toys for Thailand (T4T). In January, IHC our prior fiscal sponsor closed their operation and regrettably all of our remaining project funding was lost. Committed to continuing our work with Tribal schools, we applied to become our own non-profit organization. With gracious support and pro bona legal services from Robert Butterfield Attorney at Law, Toys for Thailand became incorporated. Officers and board members were appointed, bylaws established and T4T held our first board meeting. In May, the IRS approved our application for tax-exempt status, and Toys for Thailand, Inc. was designated as a 501 © (3) public benefit charity.

Once qualified to receive tax-deductible gifts, we organized an annual fund raising appeal to previous donors and held a T4T Open House in November. Through these efforts and one substantial private contribution, T4T raised nearly \$25,000 this year. Budget details are in our financial statement.

Toys for Thailand founder, Sasha Bilar and I spent most of December in Thailand stretching donations from our supporters to accomplish numerous school projects and preparing for the Small World Festival (SWF). Board member, Paul Marshall and 10 other international guests joined us in Maehongson for the SWF, which concluded our trip on a positive note. Overall, 2012 was an amazing year of growth for T4T; The generosity of our many supporters have brought us a great distance since 2005; I'm honored to be a part-of this team of dedicated volunteers.

## 2012 Project Update

Funding was provided for 600 children to attend the third annual Small World Festival in Maehongson. The T4T event was a huge success. Twenty schools participated in the event, representing 9 different Hill Tribes and students from a Special Education Program.

Toys for Thailand funded a water tank and filtration system, science books and fish tanks, and Karen weaving tools for Huay Pooling, a remote residential school serving 241 children.

Playgrounds were contracted for Huay Sai and Maeja Schools. Books were purchased for Nong Khiow School. Through cash donations in Thailand, T4T purchased a chick incubator, barber shop supplies and provided student scholarships at the Small World Festival.
