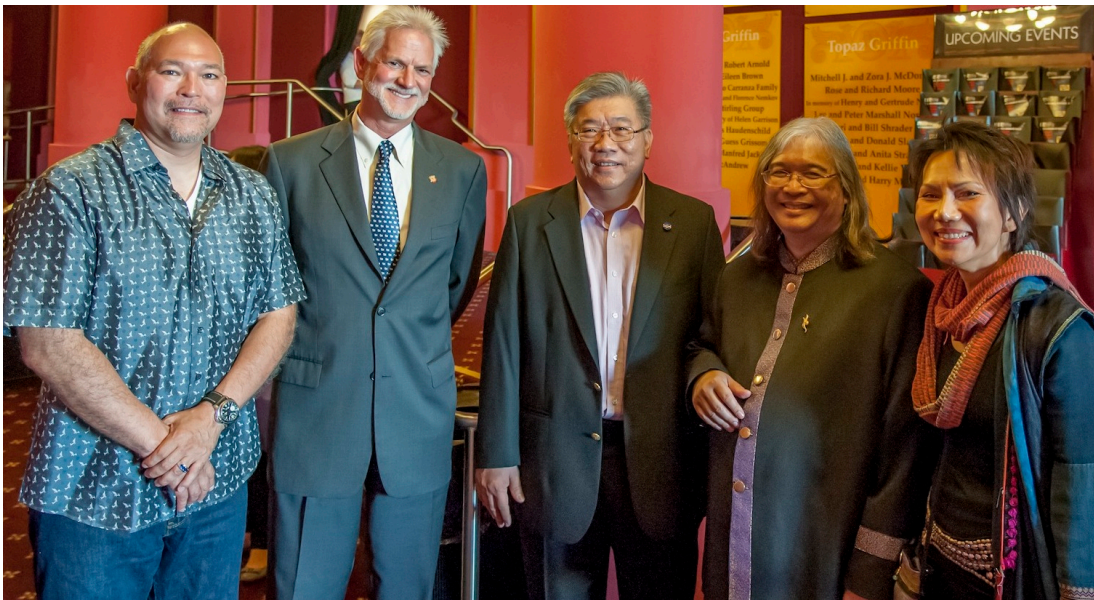

Message from Maria Miller Executive Director

In February of our second year of incorporation, Toys for Thailand board members participated in a strategic planning retreat to formulate planning priorities for the year and to set goals for increased charitable donations. I am pleased with the success of our developing non-profit organization in 2013. Collectively we raised nearly \$37,000 through our annual appeal and two fundraising events. Toys for Thailand (T4T) was the honored recipient of the proceeds from a Benefit Concert performed by the internationally acclaimed Siam Sinfonietta Youth Orchestra in June, and from the San Diego United Lions Club Charity Golf Tournament held in November.

Toys for Thailand continues to be a 100% volunteer organization. No T4T funds were spent on compensation for any staff. All volunteers pay their own travel expenses. In 2013, I am proud to report that 90 percent out of every dollar donated to Toys for Thailand, went directly to support projects that benefit Tribal children.

I want to personally thank each of our board members and international volunteers for their contributions and our donors for their generosity. I extend a special acknowledgment to Sasha Bilar for her hard work during the two months she spent in Thailand (Nov-Dec.) soliciting T4T donations, working on school projects and preparing for the 4th annual Small World Festival (SWF) held in Maehongson, Thailand. Through Sasha's efforts the SWF is now recognized by the Tourism Authority of Thailand and will be an ongoing source of fundraising support for the 30 participating Hill Tribal schools. I'm honored to be part-of this great team of dedicated volunteers.

2013 Project Summary

Funding was provided for children from 30 Hill Tribal Schools to attend the Small World Fundraising Festival in Mae Hong Son where scholarships were awarded to 60 students. T4T funded a water system and tank for the Pha Mon School. Instructional supplies including books, aquariums, DVD players, and vocational resources were donated to various schools. Playground equipment was built and delivered to three schools. Basic need items such as socks, blankets and food were provided. Tribal children's artwork was matted and framed for display at two locations in Maehongson, Thailand.
